Dr Isaac Gimba was a member of the Executive Leadership Board for Love Ottawa, of ONE-WAY MINISTRIES Canada, and the immediate past President of the Assembly of Pastors & Leaders of Canada (APLC) headquartered in Ottawa, formerly, International Pastors & Leaders Forum (IPLF). An organization which brings together immigrant/diaspora pastors and leaders of churches and ministries to foster relational unity among them and collaborations with the community and civic leaders.

Dr Gimba is a businessman, banker, former pastor in the United Kingdom and the founder/President of **Meeting Point Ministries** Canada, an organisation that currently facilitates the Unity Movement in Ottawa, bridging the relational gaps among sons and daughters of Abraham by God's covenant promise Gal.3:29, which include our English and French brothers & sisters, Blacks and Whites, Jews and Christians, Catholics, and bringing together Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Pastors, Teachers and Ministry leaders across the National Capital Region to a monthly Unity & Prayer gathering in an atmosphere of peace, liberty and joy in the presence of the Holy Spirit.

Two ministry areas synonymous to Isaac Gimba's name are UNITY & PRAYER. Pastor Gimba has unstoppable passion to see Jesus' prayer for the unity of the body of Christ in John 17 become a tangible reality and indelible unity legacy to pass on to our children- the next generation. He labors tirelessly to bring people from different backgrounds, cultures, race, church affiliations, etc together for the purpose of lowering down our doctrinal, personal or denominational flags and lift up the flag and banner of Jesus.

One of Dr Gimba's chief influence is around prayer, he has chaired the **annual Ottawa (National Capital Region) Pastor's Prayer Summit Organizing Team**, and calling Pastors to contend in prayer by his example, encouragement and exhortation. Pastor Gimba's insatiable hunger for the Presence and the Glory of the Lord will challenge you to want to have more of same.

He conducts regular/daily prayer meetings with local and global pastors and leaders to exhort, strengthen and encourage them in their faith, ministry commitment, and to a life of Consistent, Persistent, Insistent (CPI>R) prayer Luke 11:5-13, Luke 18:1-8

As head of the Pastors & Leaders Unity community in Ottawa, Dr Gimba led his ministerial team to collaborate with the **Jewish Federation of Ottawa and Kehillat Beth Israel Congregation** on 7th October 2024 to mark the one-year anniversary commemoration of the horrific October 7th, 2023 attack.

We have had several occasions including rallies, community awareness campaign, leadership gatherings to sensitize different clergy groups on creating better and more effective and efficient communication dissemination, regarding antisemitism to their congregations.
